Gabriel's Answer



323BC — 168BC





In 168BC, Antiochus—in addition to killing tens of thousands of Jews and outlawing all worship and customs—sacrificed a pig on the altar in the temple. It is known as the “Abomination of Desolation.”

10 It (He) grew until it reached the host of the heavens, and he threw some of the starry host down to the earth and trampled on them. 11 He set himself up to be as great as the commander of the army of the Lord; he took away the daily sacrifice from the Lord, and His sanctuary was thrown down. 12 Because of rebellion, the Lord's people and the daily sacrifice were given over to him. He prospered in everything he did, and truth was thrown to the ground.

**23 A fierce-looking king, a master of intrigue, will arise.
24 He will become very strong, but not by his own power.
He will cause astounding devastation and will succeed in
whatever he does. He will destroy those who are mighty,
the holy people. 25 He will cause deceit to prosper, and he
will consider himself superior. When they feel secure, he
will destroy many and take his stand against the Prince of
princes. Yet he will be destroyed, but not by human power.**

13 Then I heard a holy one speaking, and another holy one said to him, "How long will it take for the vision to be fulfilled—the vision concerning the daily sacrifice, the rebellion (abomination) that causes desolation, the surrender of the sanctuary and the trampling underfoot of the Lord's people?"

14 He said to me, "It will take 2,300 evenings and mornings; then the sanctuary will be reconsecrated."




$$2,300 - \left[\begin{array}{c} \text{Morning Sacrifice} \\ + \\ \text{Evening Sacrifice} \end{array} \right] = 1,150 \text{ Days}$$

(3 years, 2 months)

This fits the EXACT timeline of how long it actually took for the temple to be reconsecrated, and for sacrifices to be resumed. On the 25th of Kislev (December), a man named Judas Maccabeus overthrew Antiochus, and re-ignited the sacred candles in the Holy of Holies.

There was enough oil for 1 day. They remained lit for 8 days.

**The Jewish people still celebrate
this event to this very day**

They call it...

Hanukkah

— which means "Dedication"

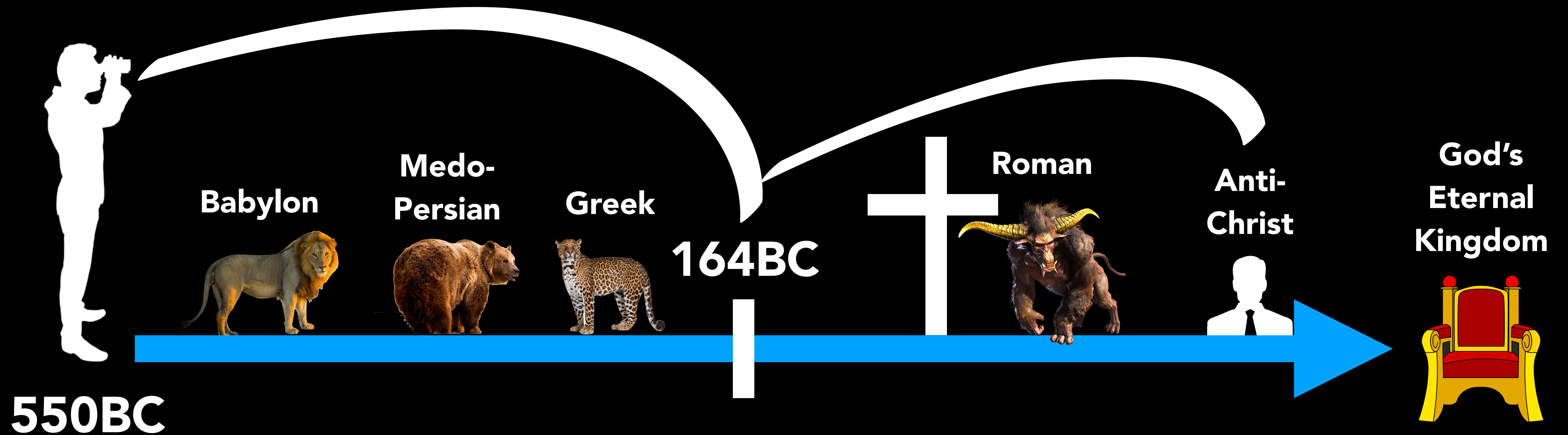
