



Small Group Guidelines

- At RESET, we believe Jesus is alive and the true source of healing and hope. If you believe differently, we will respect you, and ask that you likewise respect Jesus and his Word.
- 2. Please keep your sharing focused on yourself and your personal feelings and challenges. If you choose to share when invited, please keep your time to five minutes or less. We want these groups to give equal space for everyone to experience support and healing.
- 3. Please limit cross talk and triggering language. Interruptions and insensitive language can isolate people and take away the environment of trust and safety. Practice being a good listener!
- 4. Expect an environment of support, but we will not try to "fix" you. We're not counselors. Please only give feedback with personal permission and outside of structured group time. Feel free to allow space for prayer as directed by the group leader.
- 5. Confidentiality and anonymity are high priority! What you hear here and who you see here stays here! We will make an exception if someone is in danger of harming themselves or another person.
