First-Class (Mail) Field Trip

When King Jehoshaphat (juh-HOSH-uh-fat) called God's people together to pray, he had them gather outside the temple, a building that carried God's name and presence. As a family, gather for prayer at a place that carries your name: the spot where you get your mail!

Whether it's a mailbox, the mail slot in your front door, or a post office box, go there as a family to pray. Tell God about a challenge or scary thing you're facing and ask Him for His help. Thank Him for all He's done in the past and tell Him you trust Him for what He'll do in the future. God is with you when you worship Him, so He'll be there with you!
