The Board of Administration of King Street Church met on Monday, August 18, 2025 in the Fellowship Room.

Senior Pastor Report

Pastor Aaron praised the KSC staff and members for their ability to stay faithful and strong over the past two years. Pastor Aaron announced Vision Sunday will be August 31 and Outreach Sunday (Attend With A Friend) will be September 28.

Executive Pastor Report

Pastor Steve reported that he and Pastor Aaron met with the other pastors to discuss the proposed Vision for King Street Church to be a regional, teaching and resourceful church. The pastors shared their philosophies of ministry as they work towards their ministry plans for the upcoming ministry year.

Elder Report

Eldon Lehman reported the elders met with Pastor Aaron and Pastor Steve and discussed the Vision for King Street Church and strengthening relationships. The elders expressed interest in the "Rise and Lead," men's event being held on Saturday, September 20.
