The Board of Administration of King Street Church met on Monday, September 15, 2025 in the Fellowship Room.

Senior Pastor Report

Pastor Aaron Perry said in the past two months he has worked to identify and communicate King Street Church's identity, nature and emerging vision to staff, elders and to the Board of Administration. To refine an emerging leadership structure, he discussed the importance of the pastors, the elders and the board being the hands, heart and head. Pastor Aaron reported on his personal work for the month and strategic questions he presented to the staff and leadership to consider.
